

**Attorneys Sought to Serve on Board of Directors
of the Legal Aid Bureau, Inc., and/or the
Pro Bono Resource Center of Maryland**

The MSBA Committee on Appointments makes recommendations to the MSBA Board of Governors concerning the appointment of attorney members to the Board of Directors of the Legal Aid Bureau, Inc., and the Board of Directors of the Pro Bono Resource Center of Maryland. The Pro Bono Resource Center has three current vacancies and will have additional vacancies for the next fiscal year starting **July 1, 2010**. All Legal Aid Bureau terms begin **July 1, 2010**.

The Legal Aid Bureau is a nonprofit organization, with offices throughout the State of Maryland, which provides free civil legal services to low-income individuals. Attorney members of the Board are expected to be supportive of the purposes of the Legal Service Act and to demonstrate an interest in and familiarity with the delivery of legal services to low-income individuals.

The Pro Bono Resource Center of Maryland serves as statewide coordinator and clearinghouse for volunteer attorneys providing free civil legal services to low-income individuals. The Committee seeks candidates who are committed to equal access to justice and furthering the pro bono efforts in the state. The Board is comprised of private and government practitioners, members of the judiciary, legal services representatives and others.
